

Preliminary Notification of Election to Executive Committee, European Chapter, International Federation of Clinical Neurophysiology.

The present secretary/treasurer retires from the post at the European Congress in Budapest, August 30th-September 2nd, this year.

Applications will be sought for candidates for the position which will be voted upon at the Chapter Meeting in Budapest.

Our statutes state that;

Election of EC-ExCo officers will be performed, preferably, during the European ECCN Congresses, by the vote of the Delegates during the EC General Assembly.

To this aim, national societies will be contacted by the EC-ExCo and prompted to nominate candidates for each of the positions to be renewed (Chairman, Secretary / Treasurer or Member-at-Large). A period of at least 1 month will be allotted for individuals to apply, and for national societies to proceed with nominations to EC-ExCo.

Only national societies can nominate, and they can nominate only one person for each office, from their own or a different country. When making nominations national societies should be aware that the successful candidates for each of the ExCo EC-IFCN positions must come from different countries.

This is the only position for election in Budapest. The other office holders are as follows:

Professor Paulus, chair, (Germany)
Professor Martins da Silva, member at large, (Portugal)
Professor Rektor, member at large, (Czech Republic).

Candidates for the secretary/treasurer position will not therefore be considered from those countries.

After the EC-IFCN Secretary has received nominations, ExCo will ensure that nominees are willing to run for the position.

This preliminary notice is to allow national societies and candidates to consider their position. ExCo will ask formally for applications early in the summer in order to verify their agreement to stand and to circulate candidates ahead of the General Assembly in Budapest.
